| _____ Willehalm | 3) 15th century. The only known book of Hours to be illuminated by the famous painter |
| _____ Simon Bening's Flemish Calendar | 4) 15th century. This "mapa mundi" is one of the first known to show the world as round. |
| _____ The map of the World by Giovanni Leardo | 5) 14th century. Written by Wolfram von Eschenback. Very popular book during its' time. It is an epic poem based on the historic figure of William of Orange and the struggles between the pagans and Christians. |
