| _____ HENGWRT<br>_____ MANUSCRIPT                              | 3) 8th century. Created by the court scriptorium of Charlemagne at Aachen in the Carolingian art style. It is 4 Gospels of the New Testament. This book is written with gold and has two purple pages (which is rare) and has an Ivory cover. |
| _____ THE GRANDES<br>_____ HEURES OF ANNE<br>_____ OF BRITTANY | 4) 15th century. This manuscript illuminates the Canterbury Tales by Chaucer  |
| _____ THE LORSCH<br>_____ GOSPELS (AKA<br>_____ CODEX AUREUS)  | 5) late 15th century. Made by Jean Bourdichon for Anne who was Queen twice in her life time.  |
