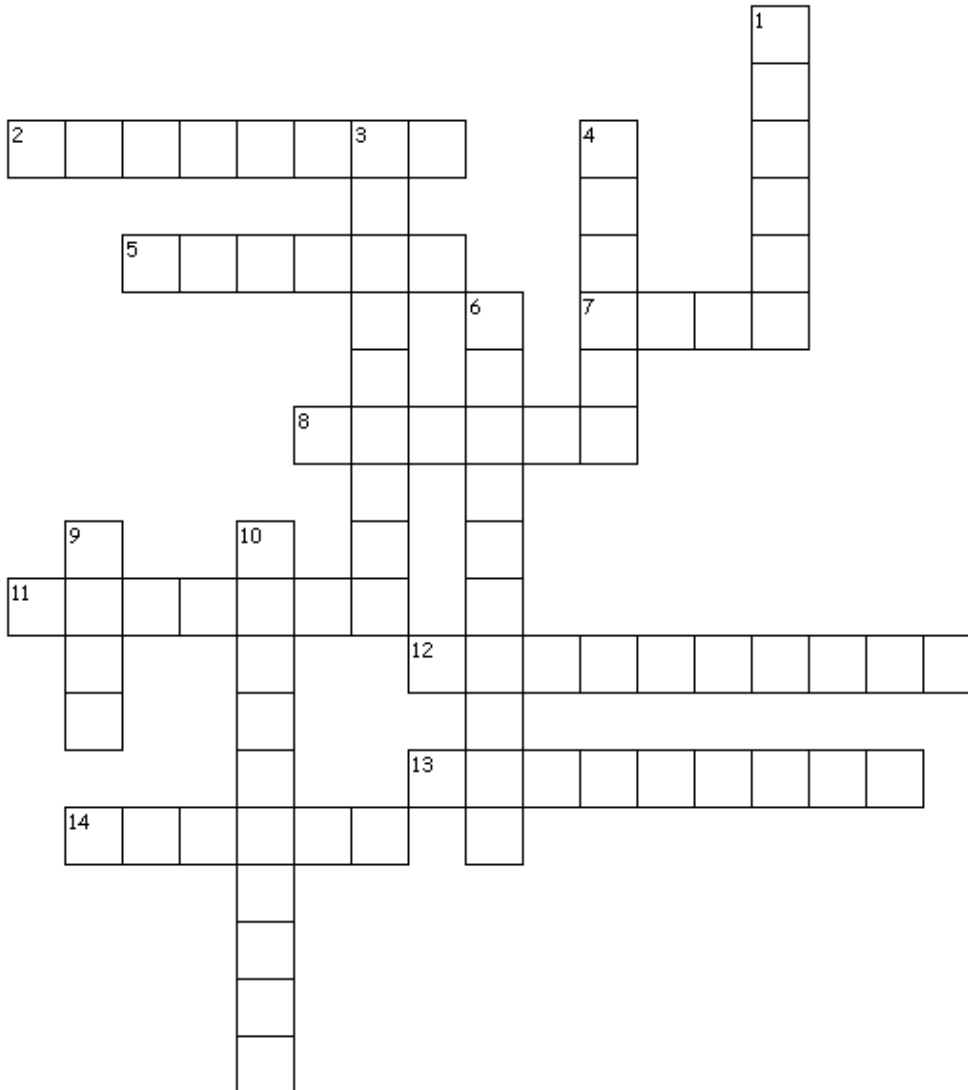


Scribal Criss-Cross Puzzle!

Answers to Scribal Criss-Cross

1 - Codex, called this from the Latin word for bark, it was a book made of folded sheets sewn together along the edges.

2 - Gilding, the means of applying gold or silver leaf to a surface like a scroll.

3 - Gallnuts, these make ink. They come from swollen bark on oak trees caused by insects laying their eggs.

4 - Glair, a paint binder made from the whites of eggs.

5 - Quill, made from a feather this was a popular writing tool

7 - Ink, coming from the Latin encaustum ("bunt in") we use this to write our words.

8 - Putto, another name for Cherub

9 - Jet, an intense black color

10 - Burnisher, a tool used to smooth the surface of things like gold on scrolls.

11 - Vellum, this is made from cow's skin and was used to make the pages of books

12 - Watermark, a mark made on paper that you can see when you hold it up to the light. Popular during the 14th century.

13 - Bestiary, books containing pictures and descriptions of animals

14 - Brush, a tool used to apply paint
